PE

Children will need a PE kit in school everyday. The kit should include a change of t-shirt and shorts and plimsolls. An outdoor PE kit will also be necessary for these colder months, please provide a plain black or grey tracksuit. Long hair must be tied back with a hair band. Please provide a note if your child is unable to take part in PE. If your child forgets their kit, then they will be expected to participate in their uniform, as long as it is safe for them to do so.

Swimming

This term **all** classes will be swimming on Thursday mornings.

Uniform

Homework

It is really important that your child reads on a regular basis, as this improves their understanding of a text, their spelling and therefore their writing.

Every Friday, your child will be given ten spellings that they will be expected to learn for a test the following week.
