We would like to warmly welcome you back to Year 1! We hope you had wonderful and enjoyable summer break!

Below are the topics that we will be studying in our first term together. Please talk with your child about what they will be learning. Perhaps you could visit the library or use the Internet together to do any extra research. Feel free to bring any findings or creations into school to share with us!

Subject	Term 1
Literacy	The children will have daily Read Write Inc sessions to develop their understanding of phonics, comprehension skills and reading. When writing, we will also be looking at understanding full stops, capital letters and basic connectives (and, but, because). We will be retelling stories, writing fact files, describing animals and developing longer sentences.

PE

Children will need a PE kit in school every day. The kit should include a change of t-shirt and shorts and plimsolls. Long hair must be tied back with a hair band. Please can you provide a note if your child is unable to take part in PE.

PE Days
