Dear Parents and Carers

Now we have a few children in the year group managing their 100 read badge, we are hoping more of you will achieve it this term. So keep reading every night! Keep it up!

Some things to remember:

- We have sports day on Thursday 8th June, please ensure your PE kit is back on the first day.
- Class photos will be taken on Friday 9th June.
- Blazers and ties must be worn every day. These should be clearly marked with your child's name. Replacement badges for blazers and ties can be purchased from the school office.
- Long hair is to be tied up with a plain hair tie. Head bands and bows are not part of the school uniform and staff will ask children to remove these if they are worn.
- Black school shoes with a sensible heel are acceptable within the school building. Children may wear wellies or trainers for the field/playground.
- Swimming classes are on Tuesdays for Year 5. The two classes will swim on alternate weeks. It will be Amethyst's turn in the first week back after half term.
- Music lessons, led by Mr Shepherd, will be on Wednesday for Aquamarine and Thursday for Amethyst.
- PE days are still Monday for Amethyst and Friday for Aquamarine. It would be useful for your child to keep their PE kit in school throughout the week as the weather improves.
- We encourage children to present their written work as neatly as possible. We very much appreciate support from home with this.

You are welcome to help your child with their homework but it is set for them to be able to do independently. We expect them to be writing around half a page for their English and Maths will be a page from their new workbook.
