Firstly, well done to all of your children who managed to complete their homework last term. We have seen some lovely Roman temples, information on Rome and a few presentations about how the Romans have impacted on our lives.

Children now have until the end of term 3 to complete an entirely independent research project, which is linked to Roman Gods and Goddesses. Below are some ideas that could be useful.

Finished projects need to be handed in by Thursday February 8th 2018.

Roman Gods and Goddesses.	Who were they? What did they represent? Are they a true Roman God? What is their family tree?
Be imaginative.	What would it be like to live as a God or Goddess for a day? Create a "new" God or Goddess. Design an outfit for a God/Goddess and explain your inspiration.
Be descriptive.	Write about where they lived, what they believed in, what they represented.

- Try to be creative and include as many text types as possible; for example a story, newspaper report, diary, poem, recipe, instructions, explanation text, non-chronological report, advertisement or poster – there are lots of ways to write and if you want some help please ask.
- You could include word searches, crosswords and quizzes.
- You may be able to link the learning to Maths, Science and Geography too.
- All work must be your own – no copy and paste from the internet or copying from books.
- You may want to make something to go with your project – it is up to you!
