Dear Parent/Carer,

The children in year 6 have all been given a Google email address, which they can use to access online content in a Google Classroom. Google Classroom is a safe and secure e-learning platform, where your child will be set regular home learning, as well the having the opportunity to chat with their friends or ask their teacher a question. Staff, who will receive notifications for any posts made by children, carefully monitor Google Classroom.

To access this successfully from home, it may be necessary to install the Google Classroom app – which is available in both Android and IOS formats. In most cases, children have found that they can access the Classroom by inputting their email address, whilst others have reported needing the class code, both of which are given below.

There are a variety of homework opportunities available – ranging from quiz forms that can be filled in by your child and are automatically marked for the class teacher - to documents which they can read and answer separately on a piece of paper, which can then be brought to school.

In addition to Google Classroom, children have access to Mathletics, where class teachers set learning, which is linked, to the subjects that we are covering in school. Bug Club is available for reading and spellings will be set weekly along with daily home reading – which they should make a note of in their blue homework record books. If your child does not have access to the internet at home – and you would like them to have home learning in addition to reading and spellings – please see the class teacher to organise this.
