Happy 2025 Year 2!

We have an exciting term ahead of us! If you have any questions please ask your child's teacher.

English

In English, over Term 3, the children are going to be focusing on writing descriptions, adventure stories and instructions. We will use a selection of fiction stories this term including *The Pirate Cruncher*, *The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch* and *The Snail and the Whale*.

Home Learning

Just a reminder that homework has ongoing projects and learning but books should be returned on a Friday for updated Maths/Spelling homework.

Phonics books will go home on Friday and must be returned on Wednesday.

Sharing books should be read at home and changed once finished.

Geography

In Geography this term, we are focusing on the coastline. It teaches children about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of Whitby, in Yorkshire.

Maths

Within our Maths lessons, the children will be learning multiplication and division. There will be a focus on 2, 5 and 10x tables.

Numbots: Children can access this at home. Log in details are in their orange homework books.

TT Rockstars: In Year 2, we focus on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. These can be practised on TT Rockstars. The log in details are the same for this as numbots.

Computing

Our focus for Term 3 is Algorithms and Debugging. They will predict what algorithms are in games, write their own clear and precise algorithms.

Religious Education

We will be looking at the Tibetan Buddhist New Year Holiday, Losar.

PSHE

The children will set realistic goals and work out how they can achieve them. They discuss perseverance as well as recognising their strengths as a learner. The children consider group work and reflect on with whom they work well and with whom they don't. They also reflect on sharing success with other people.

Science

This project teaches children about the uses of everyday materials and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes. They begin to explore how materials can be changed.
