Daily phonics lessons continue alongside our text based work around our woodland theme.
We are focusing on writing

super sentences which make sense, using a full stop/exclamation mark or question mark and capital letters in the right places. We will also learn about nouns, adjectives and verbs! We will be explaining how to care for our forests, writing information posters as well using our Geography learning to write directions.

Science

This term our science focus is enchanted woodlands. We will be learning about the animals you will find in British woodlands and their habitats. We will be looking at the parts of a plant and focusing on trees and how they grow. We will be investigating variation in animals such as butterflies and how amazing invertebrates are at burrowing!

The children will continue to develop their understanding of Place Value, for example in the number 39 there are 3 Tens and 9 Ones and the 3 represents 30 and the 9 just 9. We will begin adding and subtracting within 50 as the children secure their number bonds. We will also be investigating length & height, weight and volume.

Freeflow - including Geography, Art & Design and Technology

Our learning through Freeflow incorporates British woodlands. We will learn about different animals which are nocturnal and animals that hibernate. We will be thinking about animals homes and how we can look after our woodlands and the wildlife in them. We will learn about The Countryside Code, British Woodlands and the flora, fauna and animal habitats found in the UK. We will continue to develop our understanding of Earth's natural features and consider ways to look after our planet.

At the end of the term we will have DT week where we will be creating our own animals shelter based on the knowledge we have learnt about British animals throughout the term.
