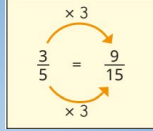
We will be reading 'Pig Heart Boy' by Malorie Blackman, a story of one boy's struggle for life.

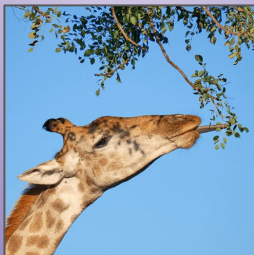
