English

In English, over Term 2, the children will be given the opportunity to continue developing their creative writing skills. We will be looking at a variety of punctuation to use in their writing as well as focusing on different genres of writing. We will be using Little People, Big Dreams: Rosa Parks to base our writing on. This continues to be linked to our History unit of 'Movers and Shakers'.

Maths

Within our Math lessons, the children will begin by focusing on adding and subtracting before finishing the term with Shape.
We also spend time daily, doing counting and times table practise.

Numbots: Children can access this at home. Log in details are in their homework books.

TT Rockstars: In Year 2, we focus on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. These can be practised on TT Rockstars. The log in details are the same for this as numbots.

Science

Our project this term is 'Habitats'. This project teaches children about habitats and what a habitat needs to provide. They explore local habitats to identify and name living things and begin to understand how they depend on one another for food and shelter.

History

We continue to look at significant people in more detail,
Rosa Parks in particular. We have our school trip to
Kent Life this term and we are able to find out about
Florence Nightingale who was also a significant
individual. The children really enjoyed learning about
different explorers and their discoveries as well as Neil
Armstrong and his exciting life.

Computing


Our focus for Term Two, word processing!! We will practise our typing skills whilst using our Google Classroom to learn how to use docs, sheets and slides.
