

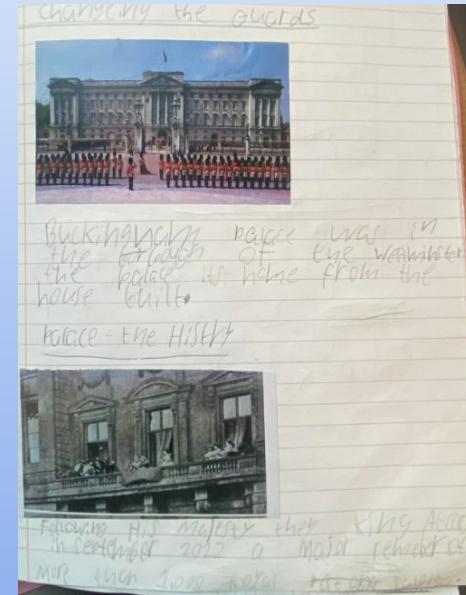
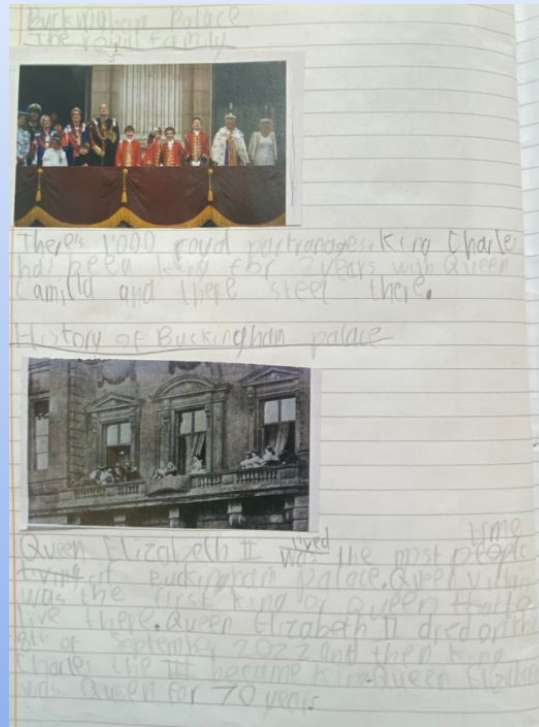
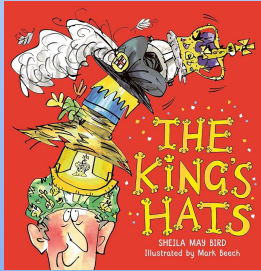
Term 5 in Year 2

Year 2 has been working incredibly hard in their English lessons during Term 5.

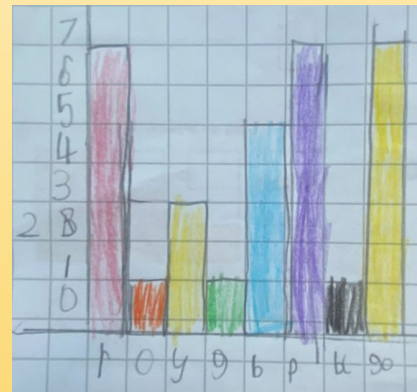
We have been exploring non fiction writing including an information text on Buckingham Palace, diary entries about Katie who went to London and retelling the story of 'The Kings Hats'.

 Is a small habitat contained within a large habitat.


Microhabitats (Rockpool)

 Animals that live under a log, such as snails and worms.

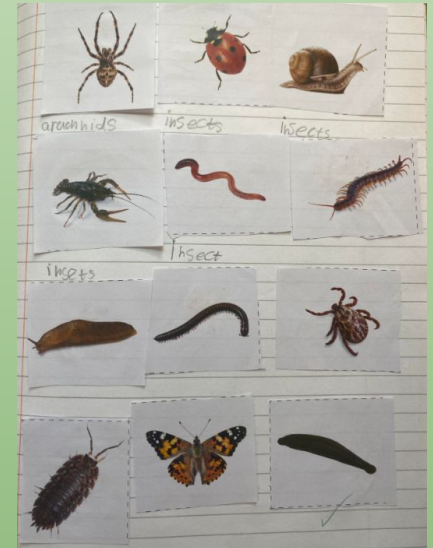
Grass

 Animals live in ponds like snails.

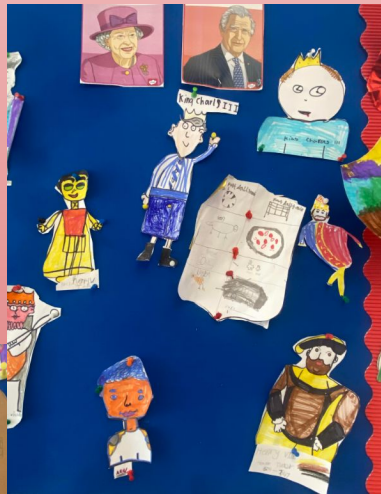


habitat 1: Ocean
 In the ocean plants are the living things and they go on the land and they go in the ocean.



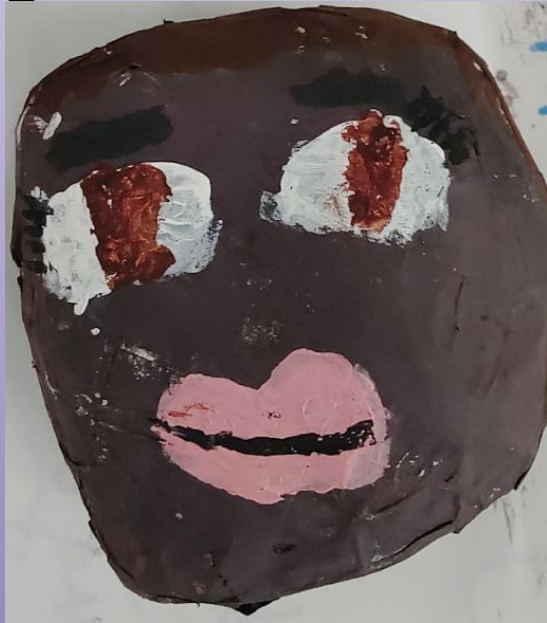
Celebrating Year
